

# **Heavy Equipment Operator for Municipalities**

In this short-term training program, students will obtain the skills required to safely operate heavy equipment. Heavy equipment operators (HEO) not only work on regular construction building jobs, but also on CITY/COUNTY infrastructure projects (roads, bridges, and ports, otherwise called non-building construction), and land development. A trained and experienced equipment operator provides necessary skills for any project that requires moving and transporting heavy materials, vacuuming materials, or lifting materials.
